This unique program is developed for international students with an engineering degree (e.g. civil, mechanical or others). It will enhance their knowledge and skills in the specialized area of engineering business and safety management.

The Engineering Business and Safety Management (EBSM) program is a two-year Graduate Certificate program developed for international students with a minimum of four-year bachelor's degree in any stream of engineering (e.g., civil, mechanical, electrical, industrial, and others).

The fourth and final semester of the program is dedicated to providing Canadian work experience for students where they go through a 15-week work placement. Over the past few years, we have managed to build a strong relationship and network with various industry partners helping students to obtain placement offers with college endorsement.

NOTE: Students should be aware that the number of approved work placements is limited and the College does not guarantee a work placement position for every student. An alternative work-

integrated learning opportunity will be provided to those who do not qualify and/or are unable to secure an approved work placement.
