



English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

Confederation College offers an exceptional English language program which prepares students to enter post-secondary studies and communicate with confidence in daily life.

The English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program is designed to prepare students to enter post-secondary studies at Confederation College. The program focuses on reading, writing, listening and speaking in an academic setting. It uses interactive teaching methods to maximize student success. Students will be assessed through assignments, quizzes and tests, lab work and participation.

Students with an intermediate level of English (IELTS 5.5+ or TOEFL 70+) are eligible to enter the EAP program. Prior to arrival, students must provide results of an approved English language proficiency test to determine their eligibility to the EAP program (e.g. IELTS, TOEFL iBt or PTE-A). Besides English language classes, students also enrol in two post-secondary credit courses, which can be applied to future studies at Confederation College.

Features of the EAP course include:

- Development of learning strategies, predictive and note taking skills
- Participation in authentic academic lectures
- Development of summarizing and persuasive essay writing skills
- Ability to lead discussion groups and deliver oral presentations
- Earning two college credits upon successful completion of EAP
