

## Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) Application - as a Student: Guide to Completing the IMM5257 Form (06-2019) E

When you begin your application for a **IMM5257 Form (06-2019) E -Temporary Resident Visa as a Student**, you will need to:

- 1. Log into or create an online IRCC account.
- Respond to a series of "Eligibility Questions" so that the system can identify what type of application you need to submit. Below is a guide to some of the appropriate answers for the eligibility questions. Please note that this is not a complete list and you should answer all questions accurately according to your particular circumstances, if they differ from the recommendation below.

d) Have you taken a test from a designated testing agency to assess your proficiency in English or French?	Yes or No. If you completed an IELTS, TOELF, CELPIP, other English/French language test, indicated YES . If you completed an English/French Language School program instead of an English/French test indicated NO.
