



## Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) Application - as a Worker: Guide to Completing the IMM5257 Form (06-2019) E

When you begin your application for a **IMM5257 Form (06-2019) E -Temporary Resident Visa as a Worker**, you will need to:

1. Log into or create an [online IRCC account](#).
2. Respond to a series of “Eligibility Questions” so that the system can identify what type of application you need to submit. Below is a guide to some of the appropriate answers for the eligibility questions. Please note that this is not a complete list and you should answer all questions accurately according to your particular circumstances, if they differ from the recommendation below.
