

Co-op Work Permit Application: Guide to Completing the IMM5710 Form

The below list is a guide to some of the appropriate answers for questions in the *IMM 5710: Application to Change condition, Extend my stay or Remain in Canada as a Worker* when applying for a co-op work permit from inside Canada. Please note that this is not a complete list and you should answer all questions as is accurate in your circumstances if they differ from the recommendation below.
