1.1	Must meet the admission requirements of the Aviation Flight Management Program.	Student
1.2	Must have graduated from the ATAM Program at Confederation College with a minimum 3.0 GPA or higher, or be currently registered in the final semester of the program with a current program GPA of 3.0 or higher	Student

1.3	Must provide a letter/email of recommendation from the ATAM Program Coordinator	Student		
1.4	Must have a completed application to the Aviation Flight Management program at ontariocolleges.ca before the February 1st equal consideration date	Student		
2.	Application Process			
2.1	Applicants submit their interest in writing to the ATAM Program Coordinator prior to February 1 <sup>st</sup> (first round offer deadline)	Student		
2.2	The Admissions Department verifies that the 2 applicants have met the admission requirements to the program	Admissions		
2.3	The Admissions Department will also verify that the applicants have achieved at least a 3.0 GPA	Admissions		
2.4	Once the applicants' eligibility is confirmed by the Admissions department, offers of admissions will be generated for the students	Admissions
