ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

Compensation

Kendall reviewed the compensation report that was provided in the board packaged. Highlighting the current compensation for board members, as it stands right now the presidents salary works to \$21.86/hour, which is higher than what is considered to be a living wage in Thunder Bay at this time. It was discussed where SUCCI stands compared to other student unions, and SUCCI is similar to those in Northern Ontario, but lower than college's in southern Ontario. The board would like to vote on a potential increase in the new year, but prior to then Ronnie would like to discuss with HR compensation for this role and its assigned responsibilities.

Elections

The final election timelines were presented. Nominations will open on January 9^{th} and close on January 23^{rd} , during that time SUCCI will hold three information sessions for candidates, followed by an all-candidate meeting after nominations close. Those running in the election will campaign between February 6^{th} and February 17^{th} , with voting dates being held on February 21^{st} , 22^{rd} , and 23^{rd} . Board members interested in running for the president position are reminded to send their expression of interest via email by December 31^{st} . A special meeting will be held on January 5^{th} for those interested in running for the president position to give a presentation, following this, a vote of confidence will take place at this meeting. The meeting will be a hybrid meeting, board members can attend virtually if they are not in Thunder Bay at this time.

Job Description

A few board members suggested changes to the job descriptions, which include gender-neutral and gender-inclusive wording, updating SUCCI staff titles, and adjusting the operating hours to align with SUCCI and related events. These changes will be made after the rest of the board members finish reviewing their job descriptions by January 9th.
