Program Requirements (for domestic students)

- Degree or diploma from an accredited university or college.

Program Requirements (for international students)

- A three/four year degree from an accredited university or college, preferably in a Business field (2nd Division/2.0 (4.0 GPA scale) where applicable)
- a) Original transcripts as well as a notarized, translated copy must be provided where applicable
- b) No more than ten backlogs/failures

English Proficiency

- a) Academic IELTS: 6.5, no band lower than 6.0
