The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Honours) program stresses health promotion, illness prevention and wellness, focusing on caring and compassion. Students engage in nursing care simulation and scenarios that will prepare them for a rewarding career as a Registered Nurse. Small class sizes, state-of-the-art simulation labs and clinical placements that begin in year-one provide opportunities to explore a variety of nursing roles. Students have access to large general nursing core labs, simulated nursing-specific care scenarios and a simulated home environment.

With an increasing shortage of nurses, provincially, nationally and internationally, graduates will have the opportunity to work in a variety of healthcare settings that may include family, community, institution and individual healthcare environments.

Graduates can choose to specialize in an area of nursing practice and eligible to write the National Council Licensure Examination - Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) required for licensing.
