Designed for students who want to develop skills and knowledge appropriate for an accounting position, this program prepares them for a career in any sector of the economy.

In this program, student's learn the basics of accounting principles and finance. This two-year program gives them the perfect foundation to continue building their studies or to enter the workforce. Students learn to record, prepare and present financial statements, reports and other documents in compliance with Canadian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles for sole proprietorships, partnerships and private enterprises. Students of this program also have the option of completing one additional year in the Business Administration – Accounting advanced diploma program which has a four-month work placement.

Graduates from the Business - Accounting program can find employment in entry-level accounting positions in organizations, whether business, financial, or non-profit. Career categories include Bookkeepers, Accounting Data Entry Clerks, Accounts Payable Clerks, Accounts Receivable Clerks, or Junior Accountants.
