## **Admission Requirements**

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (or equivalent) with courses from the College (C), University (U), University/College (U/C), or Open (O) preparation levels with Grade 12 English (C/U) Level.
- or successful completion of the Mature Student Assessment.
- or successful completion of the General Education Development Test (GED).
- or appropriate credits from the Academic and Career Entrance program (ACE).

## **Required Courses**

- Grade 12 Math (College or University Preparation) or ACE Core Math (UM602) and
- Grade 11 or 12 Chemistry (College or University Preparation) and
- Grade 11 or 12 Biology (College or University Preparation)

## **Program Requirements (for international students)**

A high school/senior secondary diploma with a grade 12 math, biology, and chemistry credits

 Original transcripts as well as a notarized, translated copy must be provided where applicable.

## **English Proficiency**

Academic IELTS: 6.5, no band lower than 6.0.

#### **Alternative Pathways**

If you do not possess the necessary admission requirements (or equivalency), we encourage you to consider our Pre-Health Sciences-Pathway to Certificates and Diplomas program which will provide the necessary preparation to apply to this program. Completion of the Pre-Health Sciences-Pathway to Certificates and Diplomas program does not guarantee admission to the Pharmacy Technician program in a subsequent year.
