Confederation College's Human Resources Management one-year graduate certificate program is designed to help college and university graduates pursue a career in Human Resources.

This intensive program upgrades student's education with a series of courses to develop their skill set for this in-demand field. Courses cover basic and advanced topics such as human resources, labour relations law, occupational health and safety and human resources planning. This intensive one-year program provides students with a skill set that employers are seeking. Graduates of the program are eligible to write their Certified Human Resources Professional (CHRP) designation as long as they meet other academic criteria.

Upon graduation, job vacancies are available in the Thunder Bay area and across Canada. Graduates can find positions in a variety of private and public sector organizations in areas related to training, health and safety, pensions and benefits administration. They can work as personnel administrators, human resource managers, industrial relations officers, personnel managers, union representatives and other positions related to HR.
