# Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that Confederation College provides affordable, safe, and accessible student housing that supports academic success and student well-being. The policy aligns with government regulations and institutional commitments to equity, inclusion, and community engagement.

This policy commits to:

- **Expanding and maintaining affordable housing options** to accommodate increasing demand.
- Ensuring safety, accessibility, and quality standards across all student housing facilities.
- **Fostering an inclusive housing environment** that respects diverse student needs, including Indigenous students, students with disabilities, and international students.
- **Strengthening partnerships** with local landlords, community housing providers, and stakeholders to improve off-campus housing options.
- Providing transparent, equitable pricing structures and flexible payment options.

# Scope

This policy applies to:

• All students accessing **on-campus housing** at the **Thunder Bay campus** and **off-campus housing support** facilitated by Confederation College across all campuses.



• Housing agreements, partnerships, and services coordinated through the College's housing office.

# Definitions

#### Affordable Housing

Housing costs that do not exceed 30% of a student's income.

#### **Barrier-Free Housing**

Accommodations designed to meet the needs of students with physical disabilities.

#### **Short-Term Housing**

Temporary housing options for newly arriving students, subsidized by the College where possible.

#### Safe Housing

Accommodation that meets fire safety, security, and structural standards.

# **Policy Statements**

Confederation College is committed to:

- 1. Increasing Housing Availability: Expanding on-campus residence capacity at the Thunder Bay campus and partnering with community stakeholders to ensure a range of student housing options across all locations.
- 2. **Promoting Affordability:** Working with developers and landlords to secure fair pricing and prevent housing insecurity among students.
- 3. Ensuring Quality and Safety: Enforcing housing safety regulations, regular inspections, and emergency preparedness planning.
- 4. **Enhancing Equity and Inclusion:** Providing accessible, inclusive housing that supports students from diverse backgrounds.



5. **Engaging Stakeholders:** Maintaining ongoing consultation with students, community members, and policymakers to improve housing services.

# **Non-Compliance**

Failure to comply with college housing policies may result in:

- Revocation of residence privileges.
- Investigation into landlord compliance for off-campus housing providers.

Corrective actions to address unsafe or inequitable housing conditions.
