## Purpose

Confederation College recognizes applicants who have completed significant postsecondary education from a publicly funded college or university with selection bonus points added to their overall application score.

## Scope

This policy applies to applicants to Confederation College who have completed a minimum of five college courses or 3 university courses. The post-secondary program must be from an accredited College or University with a minimum grade point average (GPA) earned of 3.0.

## Definitions

**Accredited College or University** A publicly funded college or university – a complete listing of accepted colleges or universities can be found on the Ontario Ministry of Education website [www.ontario.ca/page/ontario-colleges](http://www.ontario.ca/page/ontario-colleges) click on the Colleges or Universities tab and the approved institutions will be listed. Confederation College does not consider transcripts from private career colleges for admission into our post-secondary programs.
