### **Alumnus Ramesh Ferris**

Ramesh has been compared by many to Terry Fox and Rick Hansen for his dedication to eradicating polio worldwide by 2018.

After graduating from Confederation College, Ramesh reunited with his birth mother in India where he saw the ravages of polio and vowed to fight the disease. He organized the Cycle-to-Walk fundraising campaign and meets national and local leaders around the world, raising awareness about vaccination. He successfully lobbied Prime Minister Harper to commit \$250 million to the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI).

It was my time at Confederation College and the work that I did with the Student Union that truly allowed me to develop the leadership skills to be an effective agent of change for polio eradication. Dr. Jonas Salk has a quote that says 'Hope lies in dreams, in imagination and in the courage of those who dare to make dreams a reality.' I implore all of you to continue to be the inspirational role models in your communities to inspire others to make their dreams a reality.
