





Homestay

Confederation College's Homestay program arranges for international students to live with local families in Thunder Bay.

Homestay hosts include single people, young couples with children and pets, and older couples. All homestay accommodations have been inspected, and all adults in the home have completed a criminal reference check.



Students will have their own bedroom, internet access, shared bathroom, linens and access to laundry facilities. 2 OPTIONS

OPTION 2 -

Accommodation (including meals/food). Students generally join the family for meals and take part in daily family life.

Living Costs

Living costs include accommodation, food, entertainment, books and other programspecific supplies. These ARE NOT included in the fees. Students should expect to pay approximately \$12,000 per year to cover accommodation, food and incidental costs.

Off-campus Housing

RENT A ROOM, APARTMENT OR HOUSE

Confederation College does not provide direct assistance in securing off-campus housing.

Average costs:

\$700 – \$1100 per month for a one bedroom apartment, plus utility costs (gas, electricity, internet and cable).

\$450+ per student for a shared apartment, plus utility costs (gas, electricity, internet and cable).

Students should come well in advance of the start of their term, as it can be difficult and time consuming to find suitable accommodation.
