Travel Protocols Are Changing Rapidly

Students must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 in order to enter Canada. All incoming students must submit their arrival information using the <u>ArriveCAN</u> app and comply with federal and provincial on-arrival COVID-19 testing requirements. Web Registration


Web registration opens on April 11th, 2022. Login details for registration can be found in your welcome email. Once you arrive on campus, you can apply for your student ID card in-person at the library.

Health Insurance

Health insurance is mandatory. The International Education Centre arranges coverage which begins once you arrive in Canada (but no sooner than May 1st). The cost of insurance is included in your tuition fees. Don't forget to arrange your own health insurance if you arrive before May 1st.

Delivery plans for May

All first semester programs will be delivered on-line. More details will be provided at Orientation, and you can access your <u>class schedule</u> once you register for your program. Plan to travel to Thunder Bay as soon as you get your visa.



Accommodation Options

Short-term accommodation

Students can book short-term accommodation at our on-campus residence. It is available from April 11th, and costs \$100 for four nights. You must submit your request at least 10 days in advance, so that your vaccination status can be confirmed prior to finalizing your booking. Off-Campus Housing
