Admission Requirements

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (or equivalent) with courses from the College (C), University (U), University/College (U/C), or Open (O) preparation levels with Grade 12 English (C/U) Level.
- · or successful completion of the Mature Student Assessment.
- or successful completion of the General Education Development Test (GED).
- · or appropriate credits from the Academic and Career Entrance program (ACE).

Recommended Courses

· Grade 11 College Preparation Mathematics.

Alternative Pathways

If you do not meet these admission requirements, we encourage you to consider the College Access or General Arts and Science Certificate or Diploma programs or Academic and Career Entrance program (ACE); if you successfully complete one of these programs, you will be eligible to apply to programs in the Business, Hospitality and Media Arts areas.
